Dress Code

Clubhouse

Smart casual dress including smart jeans will be allowed throughout the Clubhouse.

For the avoidance of doubt the following are examples of unacceptable dress:

Workwear or frayed or torn apparel;
Shell suits, track suits, untailored shorts and team suits of any description (e.g. football or rugby shirts);
Sun tops and vest type tops;
Collarless shirts and tops;
Trainers (Except Junior Members);
Caps and hats.

Outdoor clothing should not be worn or taken into the Lounge or Family Room and sweaters should not be tied around the waist.

However, jacket, collar and ties for men and smart dress for ladies must be worn at all Official Club Functions and Matches.

We request members to exercise discretion as to what is “smart casual” and what is “inappropriate casual” and respect members who will have different views and standards and would also ask members not to abuse this trial concession.

This Dress Code does not apply to clothing standards on the Golf Course or to Staff Members.

Course

Members are expected to dress in a manner appropriate for playing the game of golf. Shoes specifically designed for golf should be worn, trainers should not. Tailored shorts with appropriate hose may be worn. Blue jeans, tee-shirts, vests and beach wear are not allowed.
